Curcuma alismatifolia Siam Tulip

Native to Thailand, this relative of the ginger produces pink-mauve tulip-like blooms from summer into autumn. Flowers are sought after in the cut-flower industry where they last up to 14 days. On the plant, blooms can live up to three months.

- ◆ **Indirect to full sunlight**
- ◆ **Water regularly so soil stays moist. Overwatering turns the foliage brown.**
- ◆ **Goes dormant**
- ◆ **A repeat bloomer!**
