Dioon spinulosum

Its handsome appearance makes it well suited for planting in tubs or large pots. Used to create palm-like effects in tropical and sub tropical landscapes. It is an attractive and easily grown plant. Giant diion has shiny, stiff, light to bright green leaves that grow in an upright nest shape. Technically the giant diion is not a palm but rather a cycad, a living fossil that is one of the earliest cone bearing plants that trace their origins back to the ancient flora of the early Mesozoic era. The leaflets of the giant diion taper to a sharp point & also have small thorns. It is advised to plant the giant diion away from footpaths and walkways.

- ◆ **Requires well draining soil**
- ◆ **Needs regular water**
- ◆ **Can take full sun, partial sun to full sun**
