Indigofera Heterantha Himalayan Indigo

A pretty accent for a dry area, this plant is found in East Asia to West China. It is in leaf from May to November, in flower from August to September. The purple, vanilla scented flowers are hermaphrodite (have both male and female organs) and are pollinated by insects. The plant prefers light (sandy) and medium (loamy) soils that are well-drained. It cannot grow in the shade.

- ◆ **Drought tolerant**
- ◆ **Full sun - light shade inland**
- ◆ **Grows 5' tall, 5' wide**
- ◆ **Deciduous**
- ◆ **Hummingbirds & butterflies love it**
